



**Shri Tapash Gan Choudhury**

Shri Tapash Gan Choudhury, 72, S/o Shri Sudhir Krishan Gan Choudhury and Kamala Bala Gan has left us for heavenly abode on Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> of February, 2024 at 7:50 AM (IST) at Apollo Multi-speciality Hospital, Kolkata suffering from Bilateral Pneumonia tantamount to Refractory Septic Shock with Multi-organ Dysfunction syndrome and leaving behind his surviving beloved wife, Smt. Shampa Gan Choudhury, a daughter, Dr. Shinjini Gan Choudhury, an Assistant Professor in History at Vidyasagar College for Women and a prodigious son, Arnab Gan Choudhury who is on the verge of completion of his Masters in May, 2024 from PAFA (Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, Philadelphia, USA).

Shri Tapash Gan Choudhury joined the legal profession as an Advocate of Calcutta High Court on March 14, 1975. A reputed practitioner in the field of Constitution and Taxation that he was, he was the Guest Lecturer with a Calcutta University affiliated law college for quite some time and also served as an Adjunct Professor of Law at the Vinod Gupta School of Management, IIT Kharagpur, West Bengal, India.
